HEALTH CORNER

SENNA

Senna (derived from Arabic word sana), the sennas, is a large genus of flowering plants in the legume family Fabaceae and the subfamily Caesalpinioideae. Senna species are used as ornamental plants in landscaping because of its adaptiveness to many climate types. Senna plant has diverse uses. Historically, Egyptian Senna (*S. alexandrina*) was used as a laxative in the form of Senna pods, or as herbal tea made from the leaves. Senna is considered to be a bowel stimulant on the myenteric plexus of the colon to induce peristaltic contractions and decrease water absorption from inside the colon, effects that would provide relief from constipation.

Senna has been found to be effective in the treatment of anal lacerations and hemorrhoids as it helps reduce swelling and facilitates quick healing. The chopped leaves or fruit as a tea powdered leaves or fruits into granules, tablets and capsules of Senna fruit dried extract standardized on anthranoids (sennoside B) in pills, tablets and instant teas. The essential oils, resin and tannin in Senna, can alleviate skin inflammation. It is made into a paste, which can be used as a compress to heal ringworms, wounds, and burns. Senna can be applied topically to get smooth, shiny, and strong hair. It also improves scalp condition and treats dandruff. It adds luster and definition to your hair.
