### TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATION

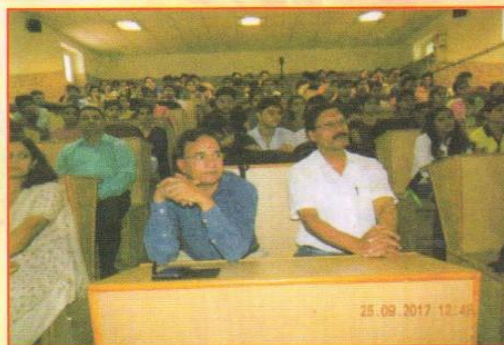

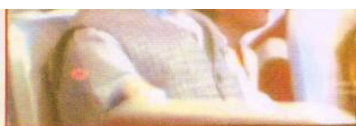
### ANNUAL SPORTS DAY
